The crowned portcullis has come to be accepted during the twentieth century as the emblem of both Houses of Parliament. As with many aspects of parliamentary life, this has arisen through custom and usage rather than as a result of any conscious

decision.


Chains seem to be a very common, though not particularly significant feature accompanying the portcullis.

The crown makes it an explicitly royal symbol, ackowledging that the United Kingdom is governed by Her Majesty's Government in the name of the Queen.

The typeface is National. The term 'UK Parliament' highlights the key role of Parliament in the UK constitution

These four national elements are embraced by an almost-circular frame representing both Libra, Latin for the scales of justice, and Omega, the last letter in the Greek alphabet, symbolising the final source of justice for the United Kingdom.

The all caps name is set in the font Enigma.

Above all these sits the crown, as the Monarch is the source of The Supreme Court's authority.
